Re: Research Proposals, Progress Reports, Final Reports

1. **Progress Reports** are due for all research funded by the Oregon Clover Commission (OCC) for the 2018-19 FY (and those whose research was incomplete for 2017-18 research reports). The Commission requires inclusion of any information on the practical and economic impact of each project to be included in the current Progress Reports.
 - a. Preparation
 - i. Please create your report as a Word document and then save as a PDF - 10 MB maximum size. Use 1-inch margins and at least an 11-point font. Do not use page numbers.
 - ii. Please save your document directly as a PDF. Do not print and then scan the document to create a PDF unless this is your only preparation option.
 - iii. Review the PDF before submitting to be sure it is in acceptable format.
 - iv. Please use this naming convention when saving your report as a PDF—LASTNAME_ORClover_2018-19_report. If you have two or more reports, after the word “report” add a one-word descriptor such as _fertility, _weeds, etc.
 - b. Submission
 - i. **Submission deadline – 10 am, Friday, December 14, 2018.**
 - ii. Submit to the Agricultural Research Foundation (ARF). Go to <http://agresearchfoundation.oregonstate.edu/webform/oregon-clover-commission-proposalreport>
 - iii. Enter your first and last name and email address
 - iv. Upload your PDF report file. Be sure to press the submit button!
 - c. No later than Monday, December 17 you will receive an email from ARF indicating that your report has been received. If you do not receive such an email, please notify the ARF office – Charlene.wilkinson@oregonstate.edu
2. **Research Proposals** for the 2019-20 fiscal year are now being accepted. The Commission is requiring information on the practical and economic impact of each project to be included as part of any funded proposal. Researchers who submit a proposal for joint funding should indicate separate budgeted amounts for the OCC and other entity in each proposal. The proposal limit is capped at \$5,000.
 - a. Preparation
 - i. Please create your proposal as a Word document and then save as a PDF - 10 MB maximum size. Use 1-inch margins and at least an 11-point font. Do not use page numbers. Please include the signature page provided in this document as the first page of your document.
 - ii. Please save your document directly as a PDF. Do not print and then scan the document to create a PDF unless this is your only preparation option.
 - iii. Review the PDF before submitting to be sure it is in acceptable format.
 - iv. Please use this naming convention when saving your report as a PDF– LASTNAME_ORClover_2019-20_proposal. If you have two or more proposals, after the word “proposal,” add a one-word descriptor such as _weeds, _soils, etc.

c. Signature copy – we will be using the OSU DocuSign system to secure needed signatures on proposals. ***You do not need to print a hard copy of the proposal*** and route for signatures. No later than Monday, December 17 you will receive an email asking you to electronically sign your proposal. This will be your notification that your proposal has been received. If you do not receive a DocuSign request by this date, please contact the ARF office – Charlene.wilkinson@oregonstate.edu

3. **Proposal Consideration** – The Commission considers research proposals January - March.

4. **April 2019** - Final approval for funding of research proposals is made by the Commission. Contracts for funded research are developed with ARF and the first installment for funds are made available by July 31st.

5. **Research Priorities** (the following priorities ***are not*** ranked; all are of equal importance)

The Commission provides priority placement support for ongoing projects. Additionally, they provide priority placement support for proposals for ongoing research.

- Cover crops in Southeast cotton.
- Improving major clover variety seed quality.
- Measuring and reducing seed shatter.
- Long-term row spraying on white clover.
- Herbicides for use on early emerging clover and weeds.
- Pollinator proposals.
- Market usage and/or market expansion proposals.
- Insect resistance, monitoring and management.

6. **Participation in Annual Growers Meeting.** Researchers with current projects may be requested to give a presentation at the OCC's annual grower meeting in mid-January to early February.

7. **Final Research Reports.** Upon completion of funded projects, Researchers are required to give a final research presentation at the annual Clover Growers Meeting held in mid-January to early February, if asked.
